A Message from Our Pastor

I want us to consider one thing: the “unconsidered factor.” I am not a fatalist, nor do I bow at the altar of luck. At the same time, I know that the Bible teaches the “determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God” while also maintaining the culpableness of our actions. But at the end of the day, God is in control. The government and media will never consider or factor that into the equation of the pandemic —and sadly, many Christians won’t either. God may protect you **from** the most fiercest storm or He may protect you **in** the midst of the same storm — but He will always protect.
