Curious, he began to ask questions and over a period of time heard the gospel preached about the compassion of Christ. Approximately a year ago, He believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; his wife, Phoahs, would also turn to Christ in the month following. Through the wonderful testimonies of our persecuted brothers and sisters who responded in love toward hate, Jep saw that same compassion. This past year, Jep and Phoahs have been growing spiritually and they strongly desire to bring the gospel to their lost loved ones. With his former reputation, this has opened up some doors for us to witness to people and communities that we had no access to before. I mentioned in our last update that his daughter, Mohm, and granddaughter, Minas, decided to follow Jesus. Also, just a couple of weeks ago, Minas's friend, Thas (15 y/o), believed on the Lord Jesus.
