Lastly, please continue to be in prayer for these national believers as several of them are dealing with persecution from loved ones.



Building Update: The roof is now completed; the final staircase and landing slab are now cast and ready to be poured. As we continue to make progress on the new building, it is hard to believe that in just a few short months our family and team will be relocating to the new property. This is a huge step of faith in so many aspects; please continue to be in prayer for the transition. There is still much work that needs to be done and funds needed. Here is an updated list of (estimated) expenses that our team and ministry needs: walkway rail: \$2,800, windows: \$2,850, electric supplies \$5,000, exterior paint: \$3,100, interior paint: \$4,300, ground floor tiles: \$3,840, auditorium tiles: \$3,780, brick labor \$6,000, and generator: \$13,500. I sure do appreciate your love, care, and prayer!
