Last month, I mentioned partaking in the town's Christmas parade, but they will not allow us to hand anything out. I volunteered to help the parade committee try to get other partners in town involved, as a means of meeting more people. The community organizer suggested passing out hot cocoa (Contactless format) to those who pass by the church. We can still pass out information and be involved even as the trailer is not available. God is so good.

I have recently had several people who have been struggling with drugs, alcohol and gambling reach out and let me know they are done with their lifestyle, and want help. There are many people searching for hope and help at this time, especially as the future looks so bleak, but it is so bright for those who trust Christ.

At church, we have had several individuals approach us about joining the church. God is doing something here, and it is a sheer marvel to watch. In the hardest of times, God is still on the throne and still working. What a marvellous Saviour.

One unique way God worked this month was having the radio station owner reach out to me and let me know that another religious program was coming into the station, and he asked what time slot to place the program so it did not interfere with ours. I was quite taken back by such a request. By the way, next Sunday, November 15th, is our 100th episode. Time flies.

God has given multiple opportunities this month to reach out, to give the Gospel, and to show the love of Christ. Just a few days ago, our city mayor fell and broke several bones, and we reached out to her with some flowers to let her know we were praying for her. The opportunities to touch a life are all around, and I am thankful for an ever-present Saviour who helps us take advantage of these.
