The year was full of so many wonderful blessings. **The highlight being the many precious souls that were saved!!!** We had a wonderful Christmas here in hot temperatures as we celebrated the Saviors birth, including a Ladies Christmas Banquet and New Year's Eve Service. During our New Year's Eve Service a first-time visitor prayed to receive Christ as her Savior at exactly midnight. Praise the Lord for an amazing start to a new year. She has also been attending church faithfully since her Salvation. Please be in prayer for one of our key families in the Kabisi Baptist church plant. **Bro. Suruj, the father of two adult handicap children, recently suffered a mild stroke.** He is in his 50's and has been unable to lift his children in and out of a vehicle - something he has been doing for many years. As a result his family was unable to attend our combined Christmas Service. He is also the sole breadwinner for his family.

Praise the Lord that the \$6,000.00 needed to complete the new pavilion has all been provided. A very special thank you to the churches and individuals who gave towards this needed project. The pavilion is already being used for children's Sunday School. **During the month of November 2019 Wendy and I returned to the U.S. for a medical furlough.** Since earlier last year she has been dealing with an illness that has progressively worsened.
