### READY TO BEGIN 5th TERM IN FIJI

Our ten month furlough is quickly coming to an end. **We are leaving for Fiji on March 23rd - to God be the Glory!** Our furlough totals include 40 churches visited and nearly 30,000 miles on the road. We will be taking over 1000 pounds of luggage with us - clothing, personal items, home-schooling curriculum, and ministry items etc. (18 - 50 pound bags plus extras) Please pray for safety during the 15 hour flight.
