Please pray for us as we wait for our departure. Our days have been filled with: family time, visiting supporting churches, helping out with different ministries, preparing items to ship (Bibles, tracts, John and Romans etc.) and filling the pulpit for several churches seeking a pastor.

It is a blessing to know that the Lord's ministry continues to go forth in Fiji. On June 28th, the churches in Fiji were allowed to resume services. It is a huge blessing to have **Br. Jerome** (pictured above with family) and **Br. Parrish** carrying on the ministry at Anchor Baptist Church. Many good reports have been returned to us as the people seek to be faithful to the Lord. No doubt, it is God who does the work, whether we are there or not. **Please pray for these men and the people of Anchor Baptist Church.**

A big "THANK YOU" to all of you who have given sacrificially to the "Building Fund". It has been a huge blessing to see the funds come in from many different people and places. **We are rejoicing in the \$25,000** dollar mark that has been reached. **Please pray** that the remaining amount of 25,000 dollars will be received in God's timing.
