Fiji closed its borders to outsiders on March 19th and they have remained closed with only 18 locals contracting the virus. **FIJI-** 1. Fiji celebrated 50 years of Independence from Great Britain on October 10th, 2020. 2. The school we have been using for services is wanting to raise the price and allow another church to

It was a blessing to be in Altoona for two weeks to be apart of the **Hope for America Crusade held September 13-20th (first picture)**. It was a great opportunity to knock on doors inviting folks to the crusade and share the Gospel.
